Our Conductor, Maestro Frederick Devyatkin, directs an ensemble of over 55 professional musicians whose repertoire ranges from Hollywood and Broadway tunes to classical masterpieces. In addition to conducting the Beaufort Symphony Orchestra, Maestro Devyatkin leads our Youth Orchestra program that attracts students from around the region (Beaufort, Bluffton, Hilton Head, and Savannah). His quest for broadening the hearts and souls of our young musicians began sixteen years ago and has grown ever since. Under the Maestro's guidance, our mission is to inspire our students to

Teach that hard work is critical to success, and

Contribute to our community by sharing their time and talent.

Our young musicians often share their talents as members of music quartets, performing during community events such as local festivals, city celebrations, charities and local houses of worship.
